

Registered nurse Debra Moore, a divorced mother of four, has worked at a state-run mental hospital since 2002. Though her shifts initially fit her childcare needs perfectly, Debra was fired when she refused to switch to a schedule that made caring for her children impossible. With union support, Debra was reinstated, and soon became the union’s chapter president. Since then, she’s faced multiple suspensions, firings and reinstatements as retaliation for speaking out against unsafe working conditions in the chronically understaffed hospital, including frequent physical attacks by mentally ill patients. Debra believes the Employee Free Choice Act will protect workers from fighting the battles she has fought to continue in the line of work she loves.
